

#### IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

#### **Consent Calendar**

All matters listed hereunder constitute a Consent Agenda and will be acted upon by a single roll call vote of the Commission. Matters listed on the Consent Calendar will be read only on the request of a member of the Commission or the public, in which event the matter shall be removed from the Consent Calendar and considered as a separate item. Members of the public may speak on any item listed on the Consent Calendar.

- 1) Receive and file a report on Disbursements for July and August 2021.
- 2) Amend the 2021 Commission Regular Meeting Calendar Move the Regularly Scheduled Meeting for Thursday, October 7, 2021 to Thursday, October 14, 2021.

#### **Changes of Organization**

- 1) Consider approval of LAFCO Application File No. 21-01 for the 1045 La Vista Road Annexation to the Goleta Sanitary District (Annexation No. 381) and Adopt LAFCO Resolution No. 21-11 that includes the following actions:
  - a) Find the proposal to be exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15319, Class 19 Annexation of Existing Facilities and Lots for Exempt Facilities;
  - b) Condition approval upon the annexed territory being liable for any existing indebtedness and authorized taxes, charges, fees and assessments of the Goleta Sanitary District;
  - c) Find the subject territory is uninhabited; all affected landowners have given written consent and the annexing agency has given written consent to the waiver of conducting authority proceedings; and
  - d) Waive the conducting authority proceedings and direct the staff to complete the proceeding.

#### **Business Items**

- 1) Consider the adoption of LAFCO Resolution No. 21-12 that:
  - a) Amends the Conflict of Interest Code of the Santa Barbara Local Agency Formation Commission, and
  - b) Determines that the proposed action is not a "project" under California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines §15378(b)(5) in that it is an organizational or administrative activity of the government that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes to the environment.
- 2) Consider amendments to the Commissioner Handbook and provide direction to staff to return at a future meeting with any changes and/or additions regarding Section 6, Rules and Procedures regarding Submittal of Written or Email Public Comments.
- 3) Receive and file a report and provide direction on the proposed Paperless Agenda Packet Program.
- 4) Receive and file a report and provide direction regarding the Large Agenda Packet Distribution Policy Pilot Program.
- 5) Consider making nominations to the 2021-2022 CALAFCO Board of Directors and select voting delegates for the 2021 CALAFCO Elections.
