RESOLUTION OF THE SANTA BARBARA LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION MAKING DETERMINATIONS AND APPROVING THE BRUNDIDGE ANNEXATION TO THE SANTA YNEZ COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the above-referenced proposal has been filed with the Executive Officer of the Santa Barbara Local Agency Formation Commission pursuant to the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act (Section 56000 et seq. of the Government Code); and

WHEREAS, at the times and in the manner required by law the Executive Officer has given notice of the Commission's consideration of the proposal; and

WHEREAS, the Commission heard, discussed and considered all oral and written testimony related to the proposal including, but not limited to, the Executive Officer's report and recommendation, the environmental document or determination, Spheres of Influence and applicable General and Specific Plans; and

WHEREAS, the Local Agency Formation Commission finds the proposal to be in the best interests of the affected area and the total organization of local governmental agencies within Santa Barbara County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Local Agency Formation Commission of Santa Barbara County as follows:

- (1) The proposal has been reviewed and found to be Categorically Exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act.
 - (2) The subject proposal is assigned the distinctive short-form designation:

BRUNDIDGE ANNEXATION TO THE SANTA YNEZ COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT

- (3) Said territory is found to be uninhabited.
- (4) The boundaries of the affected territory are found to be definite and certain as approved and set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and made a part hereof.
 - (5) The proposal is subject to the following terms and conditions:
- (a) The subject territory shall be liable for it's pro rata share of the existing bonded indebtedness of the Santa Ynez Community Services District.

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(b) The subject territory shall be liable for all taxes, charges, fees or

assessments that are levied on similar properties within the current District boundaries.

(6) Satisfactory proof having been given that the subject area is uninhabited, all

landowners within the affected territory have given their written consent to the proposal and the

annexing agency has given written consent to the waiver of conducting authority proceedings,

said conducting authority proceedings are hereby waived.

(7) All subsequent proceedings in connection with this annexation shall be conducted

only in compliance with the approved boundaries set forth in the attachments and any terms and

conditions specified in this resolution.

This resolution was adopted on October 1, 2009 and is effective on the date signed by the
