Hanson Annexation to the Goleta Sanitary District

PROPONENT:

Board of Directors of the Goleta Sanitary District, by resolution.

ACREAGE & LOCATION

Approximately 6.82 acres located at 810 North Fairview Avenue. (APN's

069-070-037 and 060-070-038) (Exhibits A and B)

PURPOSE:

Annexation to the Goleta Sanitary District is to provide sanitary sewer services to a new single family residence. The application is using lot lines of APN 069-070-036 and 069-070-038 in order toad the rest of the single City of Goleta recognized lot to the district (060-070-036 on which there is an existing single family residence has previously been annexed to the

district).

GENERAL ANALYSIS:

Description of Project

The annexation application has been filed in order to provide sewer service for a proposed single family residence on APN 069-070-37. The property is within the City limits of the City of Goleta and Application 12-127-DRB-LUP has been filed with the city to allow development of the single family residence.

Project Information

1. Land Use, Planning and Zoning - Present and Future:

The property contains an old avocado orchard and garden. APN 069-070-037 is currently zoned 20-R-1 and APN 069-070-38 is currently zoned 1-E-1. No change in zoning is proposed as a result of the annexation. The existing County general plan designation for the property is single family.

2. Sphere of Influence:

The proposal area is within the District's Sphere of Influence and is contiguous to the District.

3. Environmental Justice:

Annexation will have no effect with respect to the fair treatment of people of all races and income, or the location of public facilities or services.

4. Topography, Natural Features and Drainage Basins

The property is a hillside with minimal to moderate slopes. Surrounding properties are flat to moderate slopes.

5. Population:

There is one dwelling unit on the site.

5. Governmental Services and Controls - Need, Cost, Adequacy and Availability:

The property will receive the same level and range of service as other properties currently served by the district. The initiating agency's "Plan for Providing Services within the Affected Territory," as required by Government Code Section 56653, indicated the ability to adequately serve this site.

6. Impact on Prime Agricultural Land, Open Space and Agriculture:

The project site is not prime agricultural land as defined in Government Code Section 56064, nor is there agricultural production on the site.

7. Assessed Value, Tax Rates and Indebtedness:

The assessed value and tax rate for the property will not be affected by this change. APN 069-070-37 is presently within Tax Rate Area 08011. The assessed value is \$61,200 on the 2012-2013 roll. APN 069-070-038 is also within Tax Rate Area 08011. The assessed value is \$549,600 on the 2012-2013 roll.

The proponent requests the subject territory, upon annexation, be liable for payment of its share of existing indebtedness to be repaid by user charges, which the staff recommends be included as a condition of approval. The Tax Collector will add to assessments on the regular tax bill levied against the residence.

8. Environmental Impact of the Proposal:

The Goleta Sanitary District has determined that the annexation is categorically exempt. (Class 3 – New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures). (Exhibit C)

9. Landowner and Annexing Agency Consent:

The property owner, Kevin Hanson, has given written consent to the annexation. (Exhibit D)

In its resolution of application, the Goleta Sanitary District consents to the waiver of conducting authority proceedings provided LAFCO does not record the annexation without prior consent of the District. (Exhibit E)

10. Boundaries, Lines of Assessment and Registered Voters:

There are no conflicts with lines of assessment or ownership. The property is contiguous to the District. The site is uninhabited; namely, there are fewer than 12 registered voters.

The boundaries are definite and certain.





RESOLUTION OF THE SANTA BARBARA LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION MAKING DETERMINATIONS AND APPROVING THE HANSON ANNEXATION TO THE GOLETA SANITARY DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the above-referenced proposal has been filed with the Executive Officer of the Santa Barbara Local Agency Formation Commission pursuant to the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act (Section 56000 et seq. of the Government Code); and

WHEREAS, at the times and in the manner required by law the Executive Officer has given notice of the Commission's consideration of the proposal; and

WHEREAS, the Commission heard, discussed and considered all oral and written testimony related to the proposal including, but not limited to, the Executive Officer's report and recommendation, the environmental document or determination, existing Spheres of Influence and applicable General and Specific Plans; and

WHEREAS, the Local Agency Formation Commission finds the proposal to be in the best interests of the affected area and the total organization of local governmental agencies within Santa Barbara County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Local Agency Formation Commission of Santa Barbara County as follows:

- A. Find the proposal to be categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15303, New Construction of Conversion of Existing Small Structures ("Class 3").
 - B. The subject proposal is assigned the following distinctive short-form designation:
 HANSON ANNEXATION TO THE GOLETA SANITARY DISTRICT
 - C. Approve the proposal subject to the following terms and conditions:
 - 1. The subject territory shall be liable for its pro rata share of any existing bonded indebtedness of the Mission Hills Community Services District, and
 - 2. The subject territory shall be liable for all taxes, charges, fees or assessments that are levied on similar properties within the current district boundaries.

- D. Find: 1) the subject property is uninhabited, 2) all affected landowners have given written consent to the annexation, and 3) the annexing agency has consented to waive conducting authority proceedings.
- E. Waive the conducting authority proceedings and direct the staff to take the steps necessary and proper to complete the proceeding.
