## To the Members of LAFCO:

Over the years, I have seen the City of Lompoc try to place prime agricultural/farmland within the City's Sphere of Influence. LAFCO, rightfully and legally, has denied previous illadvised attempts by the City which would result in urban sprawl and inappropriate expansion. The reasons to deny the current application are many. To name a few:

- 1. At the present time, there are enough underdeveloped and undeveloped parcels/lots within the existing sphere of influence and city limits to meet Lompoc's housing needs. (There was a survey done for the city many years ago showing this and very little has changed since that time.)
- 2. The current proposal before LAFCO is for non-contiguous parcels one on each side of other viable and productive farmland to be placed within the SOI. All the remaining prime farmland along Bailey Avenue will be put at serious risk if this application is approved.
