Proposed Revisions to the Schedule of Processing Fees –Effective July 1, 2015

Dear Members of the Commission:

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Commission Approve the Proposed Revisions to the Schedule of Processing Fees.

DISCUSSION

The Proposed Revisions to the Schedule of Processing Fees is attached as **Exhibit A**. The Commission last revised the Schedule of Processing Fees on June 7, 2012, effective June 9, 2012 (**Exhibit B**). Processing fees were increased significantly in 2012-13, but have remained unchanged for the last two fiscal years. **Exhibit C** is a strikeout and redline version of the changes in the current Schedule of Process Fees and the Proposed Schedule of Processing Fees. The deletions have a line through them and the proposed new or replacement fees are underlined or have no lines.

Santa Barbara LAFCO averages fee revenues in the 7-10% range of its operating budget. A recent CALAFCO survey determined that the average LAFCO in the State collects 12.88%, with some larger LAFCO's collecting in the 20-30% range. Clearly there is room for improvement to help offset billings to funding agencies.

In preparing the recommended revisions to the Schedule of Processing Fees, staff considered the Cortese-Knox- Herzberg Act, Government Code Section 56383(b) that states that: *The fees shall not exceed the estimated reasonable cost of providing the service for which the fee is charged and shall be imposed pursuant to Section 66016.*..

The current fee schedule allows the Commission to collect fees from applicants to process boundary changes, sphere modifications and out-of-agency service approvals. However, there are a number of areas that are not included in the current fee schedule that relate to various types of governmental changes of organization, sphere of influence revisions, municipal service reviews, environmental fees, and other fees such as activation of latent powers, study session requests, requests for fiscal analysis, and others.

Staff has included a fee for Fee Waiver Requests because Government Code Section 56383 establishes that: *The commission may reduce or waive a fee, service charge, or deposit if it finds that payment would be detrimental to the public interest. The reduction or waiver of any fee, service charge, or deposit is limited to the costs incurred by the commission in the proceedings of an application.*

If a fee waiver is requested, the Commission can act on the request pursuant to Government Code Section 56383 on a case-by-case basis, rather than establish criteria that is different from this section.

- 1. Fees may not be charged for proposals that result from LAFCO orders.
- 2. Fees must be received at the time application materials are submitted.
- 3. Allowed <u>refunds</u> are based on staff effort that has been expended prior to the withdrawal of the application as follows:

After Certificate of Filing has been issued	50% of the fee

- 6. A <u>supplemental fee</u> shall be charged when a Commission meeting, that would not otherwise be held, is held at the request of an applicant. - 7. A <u>supplemental fee</u> shall be charged to recover actual costs for preparing environmental documents when LAFCO is the lead agency. The fee shall include out-of-pocket costs to prepare, copy and distribute the environmental document.
- 8. A <u>supplemental fee</u> shall be charged to recover out-of-pocket costs to copy documents that exceed 100 pages for distribution to the members of the Commission.
- 9. A \$1,100 deposit payable to "County of Santa Barbara" for reviewing maps and legal descriptions must be submitted with proposals that include maps and legals. Boundary changes will be completed only when obligations to the County Surveyor are satisfied.
- 10. The processing fee to file a request for reconsideration is 50% of the original processing fee amount. The fee shall be returned to the applicant if the Commission determines that the reconsideration is required to correct a procedural defect in its earlier action.
- 11. The cost for the State to review the Comprehensive Fiscal Analysis for an incorporation shall be the responsibility of those requesting the review.
