Key Site 4 Reorganization: Annexation to County Service Area No. 5

(Orcutt)/Annexation to the North County Lighting District

PROPONENT:

Board of Supervisors, by resolution adopted February 5, 2013.

ACREAGE &

Less than one acre located south of and including Clark Avenue at Stilwell

LOCATION Road; Orcutt Area

PURPOSE:

To annex this property to these special districts in conjunction with

vacation of a portion of a public road right-of-way.

GENERAL ANALYSIS:

County Service Area No. 5 (Orcutt) and North County Lighting District finance, respectively, open space maintenance and street lighting. This proposal will annex land to these districts in conjunction with vacating a portion of Clark Avenue, a public road, and approval of Tentative Parcel Map No. 14,764 to allow construction of three commercial buildings.

PROJECT INFORMATION

1. Land Use, Planning and Zoning - Present and Future:

This property is a vacant portion of a road right-of-way.

The Orcutt Community Plan designates the site as General Commercial. It is within the Urban Area. The vacated road way will be included in a parcel that is zoned General Commercial (C-2).

Surrounding uses are single-family residential to the west and north, a mobile home park to the south and vacant land planned for commercial uses to the east.

The proposal area is located within the City of Santa Maria Sphere of Influence.

2. Topography, Natural Features and Drainage Basins

The site and surrounding areas are generally level. No significant natural boundaries affect the proposal.

3. Population:

There are no dwelling units within the proposal area and none are proposed.

4. Governmental Services and Controls - Need, Cost, Adequacy and Availability:

A "Plan for Providing Services within the Affected Territory" is on file in the LAFCO office as required by Government Code section 56653. The annexing districts receive funding from benefit assessments and a portion of the general property tax levy.

5. Impact on Prime Agricultural Land, Open Space and Agriculture:

The project site is not prime agricultural land as defined in Government Code Section 56064, nor is there agricultural production on the site.

6. Assessed Value, Tax Rates and Indebtedness:

The proposal is presently within tax rate area 80012. The property will be assigned taxable assessed value when it is combined with the adjacent privately-owned parcel.

The subject territory, upon annexation, will be liable for payment of its share of payment of revenues to the annexing districts, which is recommended as a condition of approval.

5. Environmental Impact of the Proposal:

The County of Santa Barbara, as lead agency, in consultation with LAFCO and other responsible agencies, has found significant environmental effects may result from the commercial development project. In accordance with Section 15070 of the State CEQA Guidelines it has adopted mitigation measures to reduce or avoid all significant effects.

A Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) has been certified by the County Planning Commission. This document titled "Clark Avenue Commercial/Orcutt Key Site 4" was distributed to members of the Commission for their review prior to this meeting.

6. Boundaries and Lines of Assessment:

There are no conflicts with lines of assessment or ownership. The property is contiguous to the Districts. The site is uninhabited; namely, there are fewer than 12 registered voters.

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The boundaries are definite and certain. If approved by the Commission, staff will not record the annexation until the County Surveyor approves a map sufficient for filing with the State Board of Equalization.

- C. Find the subject territory is uninhabited, all affected landowners have given written consent and annexing agencies have given written consent to the waiver of conducting authority proceedings.
- D. Waive the conducting authority proceedings and direct the staff to complete the proceeding.

OPTION 3 - Continue the proposal to a future meeting for additional information.





RESOLUTION OF THE SANTA BARBARA LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION MAKING DETERMINATIONS AND APPROVING THE KEY SITE 4 REORGANIZATION: ANNEXATION TO COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 5 (ORCUTT)/ANNEXATION TO NORTH COUNTY LIGHTING DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the above-referenced proposal has been filed with the Executive Officer of the Santa Barbara Local Agency Formation Commission pursuant to the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act (Section 56000 et seq. of the Government Code); and

WHEREAS, at the times and in the manner required by law the Executive Officer has given notice of the Commission's consideration of the proposal; and

WHEREAS, the Commission heard, discussed and considered all oral and written testimony related to the proposal including, but not limited to, the Executive Officer's report and recommendation, the environmental document or determination, Spheres of Influence and applicable General and Specific Plans; and

WHEREAS, the Local Agency Formation Commission finds the proposal to be in the best interests of the affected area and the total organization of local governmental agencies within Santa Barbara County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Local Agency Formation Commission of Santa Barbara County as follows:

- (1) The County of Santa Barbara is the lead agency. The Commission certifies it has reviewed and considered information contained in the Mitigated Negative Declaration.
 - (2) The subject proposal is assigned the distinctive short-form designation: KEY SITE 4 REORGANIZATION: ANNEXATION TO COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 5 (ORCUTT)/ANNEXATION TO NORTH COUNTY LIGHTING DISTRICT
 - (3) Said territory is found to be uninhabited.
- (4) The boundaries of the affected territory are found to be definite and certain as approved and set forth in Exhibits A and B, attached hereto and made a part hereof, such description and map shall not be recorded until reviewed and approved by the County Surveyor.

- (5) The proposal is subject to the following terms and conditions:
- (a) The subject territory shall be liable for its pro rata share of the existing bonded indebtedness of County Service Area No. 5 and the North County Lighting District.
- (b) The subject territory shall be liable for all taxes, charges, fees or assessments that are levied on similar properties within the current Districts' boundaries.
- (6) Satisfactory proof having been given that the subject area is uninhabited, all landowners within the affected territory have given their written consent to the proposal and the annexing agencies have given written consent to the waiver of conducting authority proceedings, said conducting authority proceedings are hereby waived.
- (7) All subsequent proceedings in connection with this annexation shall be conducted only in compliance with the approved boundaries set forth in the attachments and any terms and conditions specified in this resolution.

This resolution was adopted on June 6, 2013 and is effective on the date signed by the Chair.

EXHIBIT A LEGAL DESCRIPTION

(KEY SITE 4 REORGANIZATION: ANNEXATION TO THE NORTH COUNTY LIGHTING DISTRICT AND COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 5)

A portion of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 12, Township 9 North, Range 34 West, San Bernardino Meridian, in the County of Santa Barbara, State of California, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at Northeasterly corner of the annexation of Cimmaron Estates Reorganization per Santa Barbara Local Agency Formation Commission Resolution No. 96-13, recorded March 7, 1997 as Instrument No. 97-012344 of Official Records of said county.

- Thence South 89 degrees 36 minutes 20 seconds West, 722.07 feet, along the district boundary, to the Southerly line of the annexation of Tract 12,501 (Tiffany Park) Reorganization per Santa Barbara Local Agency Formation Commission Resolution No. 84-660, recorded March 29, 1984 as Instrument No. 84-016255 of Official Records of said county, at the beginning of a non-tangent curve concave to the north, (and from which the radius point bears North 00 degrees 23 minutes 40 seconds West, a radius distance of 1,499.83 feet);
- Thence easterly along said district boundary and curve, 359.72 feet through a central angle of 13 degrees 44 minutes 30 seconds;
- 3) Thence North 75 degrees 51 minutes 50 seconds East, 185.98 feet to the beginning of a curve concave to the south having a radius of 1,499.82 feet;
- 4) Thence easterly along said curve a distance of 188.63 feet through a central angle of 07 degrees 12 minutes 21 seconds, to the Southeasterly corner of said district boundary;
- 5) Thence South 00 degrees 11 minutes 38 seconds East, 120.29 feet to the point of beginning.

Containing 0.84 acres, more or less.
