Projected Municipal Service Review/Sphere of Influence Update Schedule

With Pam Cosby's assistance we have prepared an schedule and projection of dates for the overall MSR/SOI Update project, as depicted in the enclosed chart.

For each geographic area or group of local agencies there will be a "kick off" meeting, collection and evaluation of data, preparation of a draft report with required determinations, review of the draft report by the affected agencies, compliance with CEQA as appropriate and public review.

The schedule is ambitious and projects completing the MSR/SOI Update by December 2005. The staff will try its best to adhere to the projected schedule and bring any changes or modifications to the attention of the Commission.

Lompoc Area MSR

The kick off meeting for the Lompoc area was held on September 12. Since that time the following local agencies have responded to the Request for Information: City of Lompoc, Lompoc Health Care District, Mission Hills CSD and Vandenberg Village CSD.
