Subject: CALAFCO Board of Directors Meeting report-July 11

Hi Paul

The July 11, 2014 CALAFCO meeting in Sacramento was very informative---especially the conversation related to 'water' management legislation. The good news is that the state is taking action and trying to be proactive to ensure that the state has sufficient water to meet the tremendous demand. Pamela Miller invited several knowledgeable 'water' professionals to join us after lunch to brief the CALAFCO Board on current statewide efforts. The two gentleman that were present were Mr. Les Spahnn, Legislative Director for Assembly member Roger Dickinson's and Mr. Ryan Bezerra, attorney for Bartkievicz, Kronick & Shanahan. A third gentleman participated via telephone---Mr. Matt Hurley, ACWA Board Member, member of the ACWA groundwater task force, and General Manager of Angiola Water District.

Mr. Spahnn spoke for about 35-40 minutes (without notes) on AB 1739. You probably understand the legislative bill (s) intent regarding 'ground water' management better than I do but I did appreciate the comments about including language that allows local LAFCO's to 'figure out how to manage their water.' Mr. Spahnn continued to emphasize that the legislative intent is not to dictate but to develop a 'toolbox' of ideas to help each county develop local solutions. Mr. Bezerra echoed Mr. Spahnn comments related to the need of local LAFCO's to have the authority and ability to make local decisions related to water management.

Other agenda items of interest:

- 1) CALAFCO budget----Fourth quarter report---There is a carry over budget of \$40,234, or 12% of the total operating budget. That is good news!
- 2) Conference refund policy---there seems to be too many LAFCO's requesting refunds of conference fees (including SBLAFCO) for many different reasons. Staff is concerned abut the lack of a firm policy to use when a refund is requested. After a great deal of discussion staff was directed to develop a refund policy that does not include 'credits.' We'll see where this goes!!

3) We also discussed the 'financial' challenge of scheduling the 2015 state wide conference in Santa Barbara. Pamela did a good job explaining recent conversations with you regarding hotel/conference facilities in SB. I was able to support her comments and added that SBLAFCO Board members were also working on options. That's it for now!
