The Technical Task Force for Municipal Service Reviews, created by the Commission on June 6, first met on Wednesday, July 17. Participants present at the initial meeting were Mike Brown and John Patton from the County of Santa Barbara; Dave Durflinger, Bill Shipsey and Peggy Wood representing cities; Mitch Bernstein, Charles Hamilton, Ron McClain and Mark Manion from special districts; Mike Powers from SBCAG, Alan Seltzer and me. The meeting was facilitated by the Commission's consultant Pam Cosby.

There was an ambitious agenda (attached) of discussion items for this inaugural meeting, with a freewheeling, wide ranging discussion of how Municipal Service Reviews should be prepared in a practical way that is useful and consistent with the intent of the legislation.

A second Task Force meeting is scheduled for Friday, September 13. The time between meetings will allow the facilitator to compile the many comments made at the meeting (the walls of the LAFCO office were filled with notes taken on writing pads).
