Following is a summary of progress that has been made in approving Municipal Service Reviews and Updating Sphere of Influence.

Completed MSR and Sphere Updates

- Lompoc Area – Completed February 2, 2005.
- Santa Barbara/Goleta Valley Area - Completed September 1, 2005.
This Fall the Commission will conduct a public hearing to further consider the area situated between the Cities of Goleta and Santa Barbara.
- Eastern South Coast Area – Completed November 3, 2005
- Santa Maria Valley Area – Completed on February 2, 2006 except for the Santa Maria Valley Water Conservation District that has been continued to April 6.
- Santa Ynez Valley Area – Completed on April 6, 2006 except for the Santa Ynez River Water Conservation District, Improvement District No. 1 that was continued to June 1.
- Cuyama Valley Area – Completed on April 6, 2006.
- Casmalia Community Services District – Completed on April 6, 2006.
