 - a) Find that the Commission has considered the Mitigated Negative Declaration prepared by the City of Goleta as Lead Agency under the California Environmental Quality Act, Public Resources Code Section 21000 et seq., for the Old Town Village Mixed Use Project, which includes sewer service from the Goleta Sanitary District;

 - a) Find that the formation is Categorically Exempt based on the creation of a District for the purpose of creating a funding mechanism is exempt from California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15378(b)(4) and CEQA Guidelines Section 15061 (b)(3); and

- b) Approve the proposal, known as the Formation of the Cuyama Basin Water District, subject to the following terms and conditions:
 - i) The name of the District shall be the "Cuyama Basin Water District;"
 - ii) The District shall be initially composed of a five-member elected Board of Directors, each of whom must be a landowner within the District;
 - iii) The District shall have those powers and responsibilities set forth in the California Water District Law, Water Code section 34000 et. seq;
 - iv) The District, if formed, shall cease to exist if the Proposition 218 Proceeding is not conducted and an assessment to fund the District is not approved by May 4, 2017, or Santa Barbara LAFCO otherwise extends such deadline; and
 - v) The District, if formed, shall cease to exist if it does not enter into a joint powers agreement or memorandum of agreement pursuant to the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act, Water Code Section 10720 et. seq., for the formation of a groundwater sustainability agency for the Cuyama groundwater basin by December 31, 2017 or later date approved by the State pursuant to the Act.
