- Oct. 2 Bills enacted on or before this date take effect January 1, 2017 (Art. IV, Sec. 8(c)).
- Nov. 8 General Election.
- Nov. 30 Adjournment *sine die* at midnight (Art. IV, Sec. 3(a)).
- Dec. 5 2017-18 Regular Session convenes for Organizational Session at 12 noon (Art. IV, Sec. 3(a)).

2017

- Jan. 1 Statutes take effect (Art. IV, Sec. 8(c)).
