PROJECT TITLE: LAFCO 09-2 Dissolution of County Service Area No. 45 (Lompoc Library)

PROJECT LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION:

All territory in County Service Area No. 45 extending from the Pacific Ocean to midway between Buellton and Lompoc including the Lompoc Valley, surrounding hills and much of Vandenberg Air Force Base.

CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment (Section 15061 b,3), which is defined as:

A substantial, or potentially substantial, adverse change in any of the physical conditions within the area affected by the project including land, air, water, minerals, flora, fauna, ambient noise and objects of historic or aesthetic significance. An economic or social change by its self shall not be considered a significant effect on the environment.

The Santa Barbara Local Agency Formation Commission approved the above-referenced project on June 4, 2009 and has determined it to be exempt from further environmental review requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) of 1970, as defined in the State and local Guidelines for the implementation of CEQA.

RESOLUTION OF THE SANTA BARBARA LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION
COMMISSION MAKING DETERMINATIONS AND APPROVING DISSOLUTION OF
COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 45 (LOMPOC LIBRARY) AS A NON-USER
OF CORPORATE POWERS

WHEREAS, the above-referenced proposal has been filed with the Executive Officer of the Santa Barbara Local Agency Formation Commission pursuant to the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act (Section 56000 et seq. of the Government Code); and

WHEREAS, at the times and in the manner required by law the Executive Officer has given notice of the Commission's consideration of the proposal; and

WHEREAS, the Commission heard, discussed and considered all oral and written testimony related to the proposal including, but not limited to, the Executive Officer's report and recommendation, the environmental document or determination, Spheres of Influence and applicable General and Specific Plans; and

WHEREAS, the Local Agency Formation Commission finds the proposal to be in the best interests of the affected area and the total organization of local governmental agencies within Santa Barbara County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Local Agency Formation Commission of Santa Barbara County as follows:

- (1) The proposal has been reviewed and found to be Categorically Exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act.
- (2) The subject proposal is assigned the distinctive short-form designation:

DISSOLUTION OF COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 45 (LOMPOC LIBRARY)

- (3) Said territory is found to be uninhabited.
- (4) The boundaries of the affected territory are found to be definite and certain as approved and set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- (6) Satisfactory proof having been given that the District is a non-user of corporate powers the dissolution is ordered to occur without election.
- (7) All subsequent proceedings in connection with this annexation shall be conducted only in compliance with the approved boundaries set forth in the attachments and any terms and conditions specified in this resolution.

This resolution was adopted on June 4, 2009 and is effective on the date signed by the Chair.

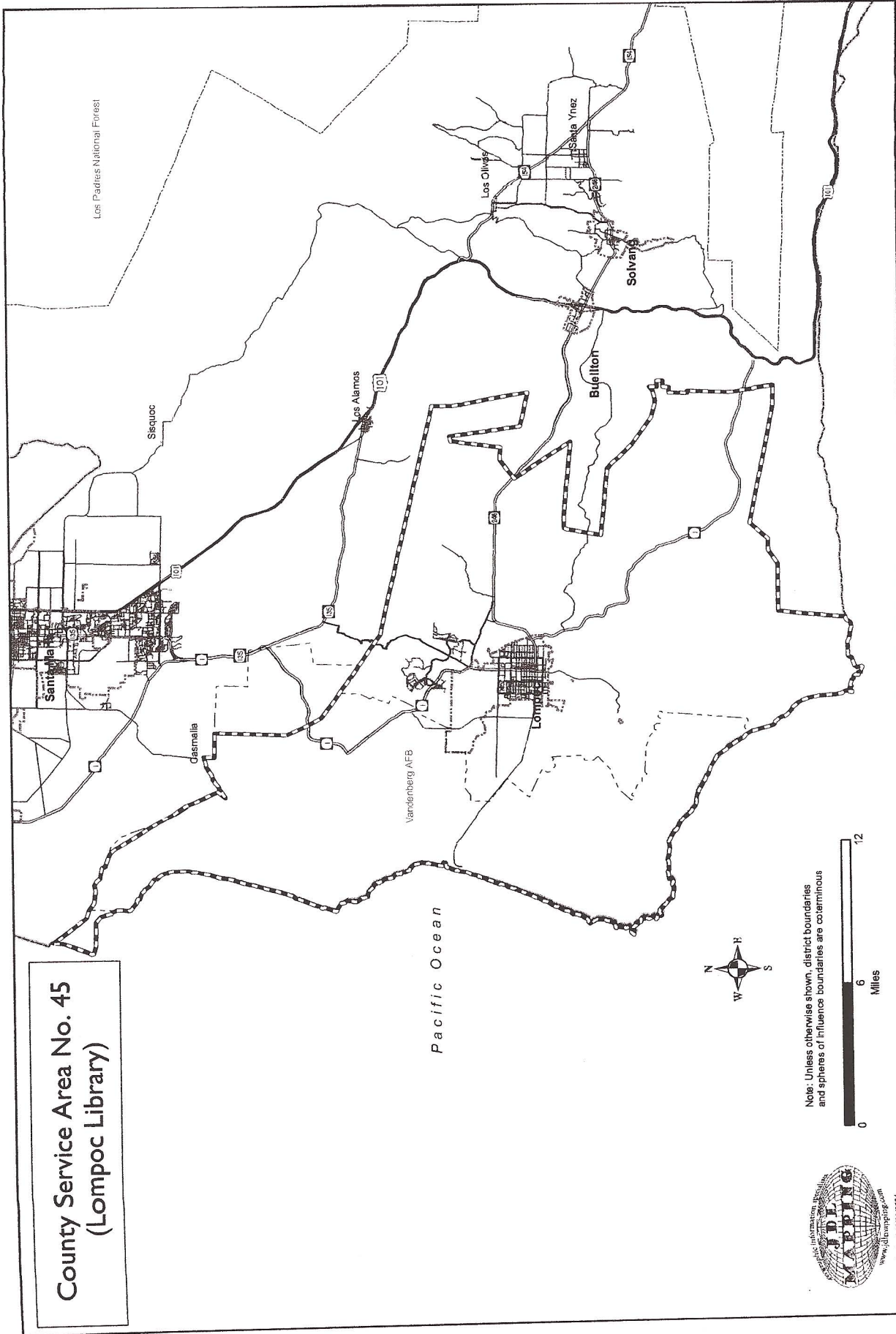
